Bro Hruza, is looking for as many Brethren to support this effort as possible, if you can spare an hour to man the stand and answer questions from the public it would be greatly appreciated.

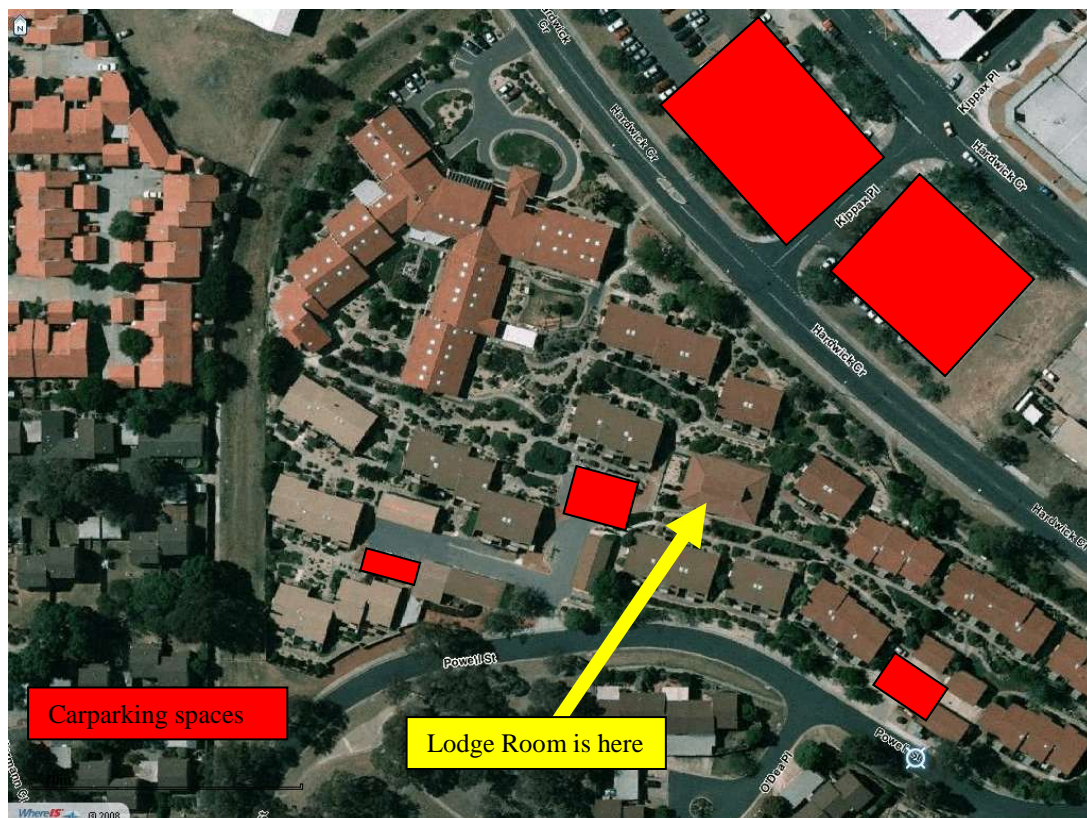
